

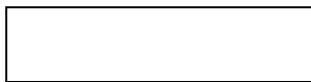

Types of Coast Guard Medal

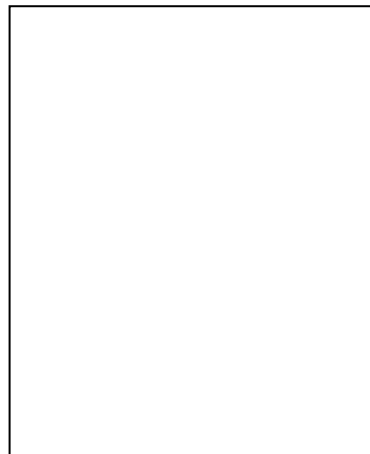
1st Coast Guard Strap



3rd Coast Guard Strap



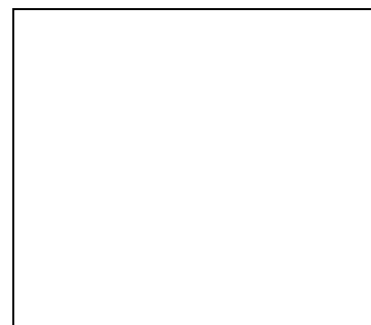

Legend of Coast Guard Medal

1. Grade: The CG Medal is classified into three grades, respectively, the first, the second and the third grades, an extra circular tag is provided between the ribbon and the medal; number of the star shown on the tag indicates the grade of the medal, i.e., three-star for Grade 1; two-star, Grade 2; and one-star, Grade 3.

2. Specification: Each CG Medal is in diameter of 5.8 cm; and the strap, 2 cm (L) x 0.7 cm (W).

3. Significance of the pattern:

The pattern of the medal is comprised of three layers, respectively, the grand sunburst, the secondary sunburst and the center. The grand sunburst is in radiation in golden color, meaning the coruscation of the merit; the secondary sunburst includes five radiations of light representing wisdom, honest, mercy, brevity and dignity with each comprised of three colors of red, blue and navy blue. Wherein, red is symbol of service enthusiasm; and blue, incorruption. The circular shield of the center represents the defense of sea territory and maintenance of the order along the coastline to ensure the national security and protect the interest of the people; inlaid with the Chinese characters reading “Emblem of Coast Guard Administration, Executive Yuan” to represent that this medal is conferred by CGA; the national emblem symbolizes the loyalty to the Republic of China, the police pigeon in golden yellow is the symbol of guard, peace and efficiency; the white balance signifies fair and just law reinforcement; and the golden dragon is a symbol of protecting the national territory and maintenance the security for the people. This Medal carries the meaning of the contribution done by the recipient not only helps the development of the operation of CGA, but also helps protect national security, national resources and the interests of the people.
