

Addendum 3: Situations in which care recipients are exempted from the requirement to undergo a professional evaluation by a medical institution

Applicable Situations
1. In accordance with the provisions of Article 6 and Article 14 of the People with Disabilities Rights Protection Act, when a care recipient has obtained a disability certificate he/she is not required to undergo a re-evaluation.
2. When the care recipient previously underwent a professional evaluation by a medical institution and was determined to require all-day care, where the individual suffers from cerebral palsy and clear poor daily life function, or suffered a spinal cord injury, amputation or other illness causing daily life function impairment.
3. When the care recipient previously underwent a professional evaluation by a medical institution and was determined to require all-day care, where the medical institution signs a certificate attesting an individual is completely paralyzed and unable to get out of bed unassisted, needs to be on a respirator or life support machine 24 hours a day, or is in a persistent vegetative state.
