Criteria on the Percentage and Number of Foreign Crew Members Recruited by the Agents Whose Whereabouts Are Unknown That Prohibits the Agents from Continuing Conducting Recruiting Business

Number of foreign crew members recruited	Percentage and number of those whose whereabouts are unknown
1~30	10% or above
31~100	5% and 3 persons or above
101~200	4% and 5 persons or above
201~500	3.22% and 8 persons or above
501 or above	2.45% and 17 persons or above

Notes:

- (1) The number of foreign crew members recruited means the total number of foreign crew members recruited within one year before the day of the inspection.
- (2) The number of foreign crew members whose whereabouts are unknown means, within three months after the foreign crew members embarked on a vessel, the total number of foreign crew members who fail to report for duty for three consecutive days and are out of reach.
- (3) The percentage of foreign crew members whose whereabouts are unknown = $\frac{\text{The number of foreign crew members whose whereabouts are unknown}}{\text{The number of foreign crew members recruited}}$
