

## **APPENDIX 1 – PEST FREE AREA (FREEDOM FROM EXOTIC FRUIT FLIES)**

### **1. Scope**

The designated pest free area (i.e. “area free from exotic fruit flies”) will be established and maintained in accordance with *MAF Regulatory Authority Standard 158.03.07: Specification for Fruit Fly Area Freedom Monitoring in a Geographically Isolated Area*; and the following procedures where appropriate:

- *BAPHIQ Surveillance Program on the exotic fruit flies at ports of entry in Taiwan*

### **2. Definition of the area**

This Appendix applies to the systems implemented in Taiwan for those high impact fruit fly species listed in Annex 1.

### **3. Product identification**

The commodities covered by this Appendix to be exported to New Zealand will be traceable to the fruit fly pest free area of production (i.e. place of origin).

### **4. Product security**

Security of the commodities covered by this Appendix to be exported to New Zealand will be maintained in accordance with Article IV 2.(g) of the International Plant Protection Convention (new revised text approved by the FAO Conference at its 29th session - November 1997).

### **5. Commodities covered by this appendix**

This Appendix applies to all fruit fly host material covered by a current import health standard issued under section 22 of the Biosecurity Act 1993.
