Bird-scaring lines (Tori lines)	Bird-scaring lines shall be deployed during longline setting to deter birds from approaching the branch line.	 Deploy at least 1 bird-scaring line. Where practical, vessels are encouraged to use a second tori pole and bird scaring line at times of high bird abundance or activity; both tori lines should be deployed simultaneously, one on each side of the line being set. Aerial extent of bird-scaring lines must be greater than or equal to 100 m. Long streamers of sufficient length to reach the sea surface in calm conditions must be used. Length of long streamers shall be greater than or equal to 150m. Long streamers must be bright colors, made of durable materials, and at intervals of no more than 5m.
Line weighting	Line weights to be deployed on the snood prior to setting	 Greater than a total of 45 g attached within 1 m of the hook or; Greater than a total of 60 g attached within 3.5 m of the hook or; Greater than a total of 98 g weight attached within 4 m of the hook.
