### The Weighting (B) of Points for Aggravating or Mitigating Circumstances

Types of Aggravating or Mitigating Circumstances	The Weighting of the Points for Aggravating or Mitigating Fines
1. Aggravating Circumstances	
If the competent authorities have given a deadline for improvement and the improvement has not been completed by the deadline, the fine shall be calculated according to the number of days passed since the deadline for completion of the improvement as notified by the competent authorities previously.	For an event of pollution of the sea: $0.01 \times \text{number of days}$
	For an event of serious pollution of the sea: $1 \times \text{number of days}$
2. Mitigating Circumstances	
Removing and disposing of pollutants or taking measures to improve the marine environment immediately after the occurrence of pollution	-0.2
Good cooperation with auditing	-0.1
Assisting the competent authorities to handle other marine pollution emergencies within one year without compensation	-0.5
Assisting non-competent authorities to handle other marine pollution emergencies within one year without compensation	-0.3
Proposing improvement measures for the marine environment and having them approved by the competent authorities	-0.05
