Regular monthly salary as defined by the Directorate General of Budget, Accounting and Statistics, Executive Yuan, refers to the work remuneration paid to employees on a monthly basis, including basic monthly pay as well as fixed allowances and bonuses paid each month: rent allowance, travel expenses, boarding costs, utility (electricity/water) costs, monthly work bonus (production, performance, sales) and perfect attendance bonus; If payment is made in-kind, it should be discounted at current value; The above figures do not include the deduction of income tax, insurance payments and union membership dues.
2. Total monthly salary as defined by the Directorate General of Budget, Accounting and Statistics, Executive Yuan, refers to the actual salary paid to an employee at the end of the month, including regular salary, overtime pay and other irregular earnings.
