<p>Hakka Affairs Professional Medals</p>	<p>Class 1~ Class 3</p>	<p>The medal is 5.8cm. The miniature medal is 1.8cm.</p>	<p>1. The principal part of this medal consists of first radiance, second radiance and upper cover. The first radiance is mainly comprised of two parts: the first part is designed into golden brilliant long metal lines to present an image of shining glory. The second part is designed into a pentagonal golden inlayed block with a red Hakka cloth to represent that Hakka people focus on the five cardinal relationships of the family. The inlayed golden edge reaffirms the gleam and strengthens the entire shape. The second radiance starts from an image of a blue Hakka shirt. The blue color combines with radiating rays to present an intercrossed and layered pattern, showing the simple, plain, diligent, firm and hardworking Hakka spirit. The upper cover is a round inlayed golden edge with the emblem inlayed in the center, highlighting the Hakka Affairs professional medals. The inlayed edge design of the layer echoes the pattern of the first radiance design.</p> <p>2. The medals are graded into Class 1, Class 2 and Class 3 together with a class tablet between the ribbon and medal which is separated with gold, silver and bronze. The gold signifies Class 1, silver signifies Class 2 and bronze signifies Class 3. The Class tablet connects the ribbon and medal, centered on Hakka to reinforce the diversified combination of Hakka culture by curves, thickness of lines, hollows and other organic elements. It also expresses the ease of the Hakka spirit in their attitude toward life and their toughness. All medals are attached with a ribbon which is shown below.</p>
