

## Article 2

The tolerances of atomic dust and radioactivity contamination in foods:

Radioactive nucleus Food category	$^{131}\text{I}$	$^{134}\text{Cs} + ^{137}\text{Cs}$
Milk and Milk products	55 Bq/kg	50Bq/kg
Infant foods	55 Bq/kg	50Bq/kg
Soft drink and bottled water	100Bq/kg	10Bq/kg
Other foods <sup>(1)(2)</sup>	100Bq/kg	100Bq/kg

Note. The standards apply to a nuclear or radiological contamination, which includes both accidents and malevolent actions.

<sup>(1)</sup>Dry foods intended to be consumed in a reconstituted state (e.g.,dried products of mushrooms, seaweeds, fish, shellfish and vegetables)shall apply to the tolerancefor “Other foods” after reconstitute to ready-to-eat state.Foods intended to be consumed in a dried state (e.g.,nori,niboshi, dried cuttlefish, raisin)shall directly apply to the tolerance for “Other foods”.

<sup>(2)</sup>For tea leaves, a liquid extract obtained after brewing process shall apply to the tolerance for “Soft drink and bottled water”.
