Note:

1. This form is delivered to both the mountainous terrain and the plain ground. Delivery numbers begin every year on January 1 and both forms are numbered in parallel. This form is width 29.7 cm × height 21cm.

2. This form consists of four counterparts. The first counterpart is kept by the unit at the place of departure. The second counterpart is kept by the self-shipment operation unit, and is also used by the carrier to apply for freight payment when transport is subcontracted. The third counterpart is kept by the verification and acceptance unit. The fourth counterpart will be sent to the unit at the place of departure by the verification and acceptance unit for verification purposes.

3. When forest products are transported from mountainous terrain to plain ground, the delivery column will be stamped by the mountainous terrain timber gathering personnel, and the plain ground stamp area shall be crossed out; the verification and acceptance column shall be stamped by the plain ground personnel, while the log yard stamp area shall be crossed out; and so on.
