

Schedule 1

Start-up permits, incorporation permits, or reapplications for incorporation permits shall not be allowed for private employment institutions and their branch offices, as well as the percentage and the number of unknown whereabouts that should be periodically checked and submitted to the competent authorities in municipality or administrative counties (cities) for imposing punitive fines.

Number of expatriates reported related to employment permit requests.	Percentage and number of unknown whereabouts
1 person to 30 persons	Above 10%
31 persons to 100 persons	Above 5% and 3 persons
101 persons to 200 persons	Above 4% and 5 persons
201 persons to 500 persons	Above 3.22% and 8 persons
501 persons and above	Above 2.45% and 17 persons

Note 1: Number of expatriates reported to request an employment permit.

1. Regulations set out in Subparagraph 12 under paragraph 1 of Article 15: Means the total number of expatriates reported for requesting the employment permit within 2 years before the application submittal day.
2. Regulations set out in Article 15-1: Means the total number of expatriates reported for requesting the employment permit within 1 year before the checking day.

Note 2: Percentage of unknown whereabouts = $\frac{\text{Number of unknown whereabouts}}{\text{Number of expatriates reported for requesting the employment permit}}$

Note 3: Number of unknown whereabouts – Means the total number of expatriates that are absent from work and out of touch for 3 consecutive days for which, the employment permit has been canceled or will not be issued.
