

Annex 15 Qualification for Occupational Safety and Health Education and Training Lecturers

1. Qualification for educational training lecturers of occupational safety management specialist and occupational health management specialist:
 - (1) Individual equipped with teaching experience of related courses in colleges or universities for three years or more.
 - (2) Individual equipped with a doctoral degree in industrial safety, industrial hygiene or related curriculum and equipped with relevant working experience for one year or more.
 - (3) Individual equipped with a master's degree in industrial safety, industrial hygiene or related curriculum and equipped with relevant working experience for three years or more.
 - (4) Individual qualified for certified industrial safety professional or certified industrial and mining hygiene professional and equipped with relevant working experience for five years or more.
 - (5) Individual qualified for professional medical specialist or physician and equipped with labor health service working experience for two years or more.
 - (6) Individual equipped with relevant working experience of labor inspectors for five years or more.
 - (7) Individual graduated from relevant departments of colleges or universities and qualified for occupational safety management specialist, occupational health management specialist or equipped with the license of Level A labor safety management staff, Level A labor health management staff, and also equipped with relevant working experience for seven years or more.

Notes:

1. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 1 to 9

of Subparagraph 3 of Section I Occupational Safety Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, and the professional courses of Item 1 of Subparagraph 3 of Section II Occupational Health Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant industrial safety academic background or working experience as the lecturer of such courses.

2. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 10 to 13 of Subparagraph 3 of Section I Occupational Safety Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, and the professional courses of Items 2 to 13 of Subparagraph 3 of Section II Occupational Health Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant industrial health academic background or working experience as the lecturer of such courses.
 3. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 14 to 15 of Subparagraph 3 of Section I Occupational Safety Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, and the professional courses of Items 14 to 17 of Subparagraph 3 of Section II Occupational Health Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant academic background or working experience in medical, nursing or industrial health as the lecturer of such courses.
2. Qualification for educational training lecturers of occupational safety and health management staff, construction safety assessors and process safety assessors:
 - (1) Individual equipped with teaching experience of related courses

in colleges or universities for two years or more.

- (2) Individual equipped with a doctoral degree in industrial safety, industrial hygiene or related curriculum and equipped with relevant working experience for one year or more.
- (3) Individual equipped with a master's degree in industrial safety, industrial hygiene or related curriculum and equipped with relevant working experience for three years or more.
- (4) Individual qualified for certified industrial safety professional or certified occupational hygiene professional and equipped with relevant working experience for three years or more.
- (5) Individual qualified for professional medical specialist or physician and equipped with labor health service working experience for two years or more.
- (6) Individual equipped with relevant working experience of labor inspectors for three years or more.
- (7) Individual graduated from relevant departments of colleges or universities and qualified for occupational safety and health management staff or equipped with the license of Level B occupational safety and health management staff, and also equipped with relevant working experience for five years or more. However, for the educational training of construction safety assessors or process safety assessors, the lecturers shall be qualified the training for construction safety assessor or process safety assessor, and shall be equipped with relevant working experience in construction safety assessment or process safety assessment for five years or more.

Notes:

- 1. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 1 to 9 of Subparagraph 3 of Section III Occupational Safety

Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant academic background or working experience in industrial safety as the lecturer of such courses.

2. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 10 to 13 of Subparagraph 3 of Section III Occupational Safety Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant academic background or working experience in industrial health as the lecturer of such courses.

3. For Annex 3, the professional courses referred to in Items 14 to 15 of Subparagraph 3 of Section III Occupational Safety Management Specialist Education and Trainings Courses and Hours, shall be taught by an individual equipped with relevant academic background or working experience in medical, nursing or industrial safety as the lecturer of such courses.

3. Qualification for educational training lecturers of workplace monitoring personnel:

(1) Individual equipped with teaching experience of workplace monitoring related courses in colleges or universities for two years or more.

(2) Individual graduated from relevant departments of colleges or universities and equipped with the license of Level A workplace monitoring personnel, and also equipped with relevant working experience in workplace monitoring for five years or more.

(3) Individual graduated from relevant departments of colleges or universities and equipped with the license of certified occupational hygiene specialist, and also equipped with relevant working experience in workplace monitoring for three years or

more.

- (4) Individual equipped with occupational health inspection experience as labor inspectors for three years or more.

4. Qualification for educational training lecturers of first aid personnel:

Lecturers shall be selected from cooperative teaching hospitals or hospitals that have a medical/nursing program. The experienced medical personnel should have actual experience in emergency medical services for at least three years or more, and shall also be equipped with any one of the following qualifications:

- (1) Physician.
- (2) Nursing personnel.
- (3) Equipped with the license of senior or intermediate level of emergency medical technician specified by the central competent authority of health and welfare.

5. Qualification for lecturers of education and trainings other than occupational safety management specialist, occupational health management specialist, occupational safety and health management staff, construction safety assessors, process safety assessors, workplace monitoring personnel, first aid personnel, labor health service nursing personnel and labor health service-related personnel:

- (1) Individual graduated from relevant departments of colleges or universities, and also equipped with relevant working experience for three years or more.
- (2) Lecturers of technical courses shall graduate from high school, vocational high school and further education establishments, and shall be equipped with licenses of Level A, B or single level technician or shall qualify relevant trainings, equipped with the qualification of operators, and having working experience of relevant operations or operational practices for three years or

more.

- (3) Individual equipped with practical experience or specialties in relevant teaching courses for ten years or more.
- (4) Individual equipped with relevant working experience of labor inspectors for three years or more.
