

**Attachment 4 Scope and Criteria for Examination of Evidence of Physical Education
Related Achievement Submitted for Teacher Accreditation Reviews**

Scope	Regulations
<p>If a teacher in the field of athletic competition or any athlete(s) coached by the teacher has participated in any major domestic and/or international sports tournament and won a major place, the teacher may submit evidence of that physical education related achievement for an accreditation review.</p> <p>The competitions which are considered to be the “major domestic and international sports tournaments” referred to in the previous paragraph are set out in Attachment 4-1.</p> <p>The evidence of physical education related achievement referred to in Paragraph 1, i.e., evidence of achievement in sports means evidence of winning a major place that has been issued by the organizer of the tournament. The criteria are set out in Attachment 4-2.</p>	<p>1. An applicant submitting evidence of physical education related achievement shall meet the following requirements:</p> <p>(1) Shall also submit five copies of each evidence of physical education related achievement, and evidence that the athlete’s winning a recorded place in an international tournament shall meet the requirement stipulated in Article 21, Paragraph 1, Subparagraph 4 that any such place was won since the applicant was accredited at their current level.</p> <p>(2) Shall attach three copies of each competition-related report, and the contents of the reports shall satisfy the provisions of point 2 below. If evidence of two or more physical education related achievements is submitted, the applicant shall select one of the achievements as their representative achievement and any other achievements are for reference. Related achievements which form a series may be amalgamated and presented as one representative achievement, and any other related achievements or works may serve as reference material.</p> <p>(3) When an applicant submits evidence of achievement of any athlete(s) they have coached, the applicant shall submit the coach certificate issued by the organizers of the tournament at which the athlete won a major place.</p> <p>(4) If the applicant has won any other award(s) for the achievement of which they submitted evidence, they may also submit evidence of the other award(s).</p> <p>(5) If the representative achievement has been brought about by several people, only one of those people may present the achievement for an accreditation review, as their representative achievement. When it is submitted, the other persons shall relinquish their right to present that evidence of</p>

	<p>physical education related achievement as for an accreditation review as their own representative achievement. The applicant shall specify in writing the part(s) of the work in which they participated, and the other persons involved in bringing that achievement about shall sign and certify the written statement.</p> <p>(6) When any evidence of physical education related achievement that has previously been submitted for an accreditation review when being accredited at their current level is included in the currently submitted material, the applicant shall include all documentation submitted at that time.</p> <p>(7) If the teacher's material submitted to be accredited at a particular level was not given a passing mark at a previous review, but the evidence of their achievement(s) that they submitted satisfies the provisions of the previous six paragraphs, the teacher may resubmit three copies of that evidence of achievement and three copies each of the previously submitted competition-related reports that have since had at least half of the content amended to the current accreditation review.</p> <p>2. The competition-related report(s) referred to in Subparagraph 2 of the previous point refers to any report on the results of research on the theory and practices of the sports training undertaken by the teacher or any athlete(s) coached by the teacher. The report shall include the following major items:</p> <p>(1) Case description(s).</p> <p>(2) The theoretical basis.</p> <p>(3) The teacher's personal training plan(s) (including taking part in competitions) or training plan(s) used by athletes coached by the teacher (including taking part in competitions).</p> <p>(4) The process and outcome(s) of the teacher's personal training plan(s) (including taking part in competitions) or of training plan(s) used by athletes coached by the teacher (including taking part in competitions).</p>
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	<p>3. If the sport achievement related reports submitted for review are approved, and if the provisions of the proviso in Paragraph 3 of Article 21 permitting the submitted material to not be published or to be placed under embargo from being published for a prescribed period do not apply, the institution shall make the material publicly available on the institution's website and in its library, and/or have it published and distributed in relevant domestic and overseas publications.</p>
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
