

## **Attachment 6 Regulations Governing Test Flights of Drone**

### **1. Testing Requirements**

In order to carry out test flight of the drone for the purpose of confirming that the design, manufacturing and modification of the drone comply with the inspection standards, the applicant shall, prior to the test flight, submit the documents set out in Article 14 herein to CAA for application for test flight, except in the case of drones which are of simple type and structure as announced by CAA.

### **2. Rules Governing Testing Flights**

- (1) The applicant shall ensure that the drone and its relevant equipment are in proper working order before the test flight;
- (2) The applicant shall provide sufficient safety measures in the course of each test flight to enable the flight operators to prevent the occurrence of hazardous incidents during emergency;
- (3) In the event of any of the following, the applicant shall suspend the test flight, and may only continue the test flight only after corrective measures are taken:
  - (i) The operator is unable or unwilling to carry out any of the items in the test flight;
  - (ii) Any irregularity is discovered which may make the subsequent test statistics meaningless, or make continuing the test dangerous.
