


Pattern of National Emblem

National Emblem and National Flag of the Republic of China Act

Symbol

Xie He Wan Bang = Blue Circle

A B C D = White Sun

a b c d e f g h i j k l = top angles of the 12 white rays

Blue ring between A/B/C/D and E/F/G/H = Blue ring between the white sun and the 12 white rays

Zhong = center of the white sun

ZhongA = radius of the white sun

ZhongXie = radius of the blue circle

Sizes/Ratios

(Subparagraph 2, Article 3) ZhongA : ZhongXie = 1:3

(Subparagraph 3, Article 3) Zhonga : ZhongA = 2:1

(Subparagraph 4, Article 3) AE = AC/15

(Subparagraph 5, Article 3) Each angle of a b c d e f g h i j k l = 30 degrees, totaling 360 degrees

(Subparagraph 6, Article 3) "a" angle faces north

"g" angle faces south

"d" angle faces east

"j" angle faces west

Description of Geometric Drawing

1. Use the Zhong-Ze straight line, with the middle point as the center of the circle, and Zhong-Jia as the radius to draw a circle of ABCD to form the white sun.
2. On the Zhong-Ze line, take the length equivalent to 1/15 of AC and use the middle point as the center of the circle and Zhong-Wu as the radius, drawing a circle of EFGH. The circle between this circle and the ABCD circle is the blue ring.
3. Extend the Zhong-Ze line through points C and g. Use the middle point as the center of the circle and the Zhong-Ze line as the radius and draw a circle. Divide the a-g arc into 6 equal parts to get 5 points: b, c, d, e, f. Connect the 5 points to the center of the circle. The extensions of each line will cross the non-divided arc, forming 5 more points: h, i, j, k, l.
4. On the circle of a b c d e f g h i j k l, connect two neighboring points every 4 points to form the 12 rays, with a top angle of 30 degrees each and with all 12 angles totaling 360 degrees.
5. Extend the Zhong-Ze line to the point of Xie so that the ratio of Zhong-Xie to Zhong-Jia becomes 3:1. Use the middle point as the center of the circle, use Zhong-Xie as the radius and draw a circle to extend the a-g line and d-j line to

the outer circle, connecting to the 4 points: Xie, Wang, He and Bang, forming the Xie/Wang/He/Bang blue circle.
