Instructions for Filling-in the Application Form for Export Certificate

Applicant shall complete the columns from 1 to 11.

No.	Column	Instructions
(1)	Applicant	The applicant's name with his stamp affixed. (If the applicant is a company, stamps of the company and its responsible person shall be affixed).
(2)	Unified code	The business registration number of the applicant and the National ID card number of its responsible person. (If the applicant is an individual person, please fill in his/her National ID card number.)
(3)	Address and Tel. No.	Applicant's address and telephone number.
(4)	Country of destination	1. Please fill in the name of the country or destination for the fishing vessel. (The name of destination port is not required.) 2. Please fill in the country code as per "Customs Operation and Statistical Code" in the upper right box.
(5)	Transshipment port	If the fishing vessel will be transshipped in port during transport, fill in the name of the transshipment port and the country code. The column may be left blank if no transshipment port will be used.
(6)	Country of buyer	1. Please fill in the name of the vessel buyer and his/her country. 2. Please fill the country code as per "Customs Operation and Statistical Code" in the upper right box.
(7)	Item	Where there are two or more exported commodities, each of the commodities shall be numbered with 1, 2, 3..., and the description of each of the commodities and C.C.C. Code shall be in the same line.
(8)	Description of Commodities, Spec. and Brand or Maker, etc.	1. Description of Commodities: name of the fishing vessel 2. Specifications: (1) Gross tonnage of the fishing vessel; (2) Type of Fishery; (3) Overall length of the fishing vessel. 3. In case where the column of the commodity does not provide enough room for completion, the needed pages may be expanded as necessary. Please state the total page and which page clearly in the top, except for the last page which is allowed without the total page.

Required Documents		1. For an application for export a ROC fishing vessel, the following documents shall be enclosed with: (1) An application Form. (2) The original and a copy of the fishing license of the fishing vessel, and the original of the fuel allocation handbook. (3) Two copies of the certificate of nationality of the fishing vessel or fishing license of small craft. (4) Two copies of the contract for the sale and purchase of the vessel. (5) The original and a copy of a document proving the registration of the fishing vessel has been accepted by the new flag State, which shall be certified or attested by the relevant ROC diplomatic mission. (6) The original and a copy of a document issued by the competent fisheries

	<p>authority of the new flag State stating its consent to take over responsibility for managing the fishing vessel and to comply with the management measures adopted by the relevant regional fisheries management organization, which shall be certified or attested by the relevant ROC diplomatic mission.</p> <p>(7) For the application for the export of a tuna purse seiner, the original of each document certified by the relevant regional fisheries management organization or the new flag State proving that another tuna purse seiner has been replaced in advance.</p> <p>2. For an application for export a ROC fishing vessel, the following documents shall be enclosed with:</p> <p>(1) An application form for the export certificate.</p> <p>(2) Two photos of the fishing vessel from both starboard and portside and two photos of the fishing gear in part, in the size of five (5) inches multiply seven (7) inches.</p> <p>(3) The original and a copy of the document proving the registration of the fishing vessel has been accepted by the flag State or the certificate of nationality of the fishing vessel, which shall be certified or attested by the relevant ROC diplomatic mission.</p> <p>(4) The original and a copy of the fishing license issued by the flag State, which shall be certified or attested by the relevant ROC diplomatic mission.</p> <p>(5) A copy of the vessel building permit issued by the central competent authority.</p> <p>3. Where any of the documents required to be submitted as referred to in paragraph 1 and 2 is not written in Chinese or English, a Chinese translation certified by a competent court or notary public shall be enclosed with such document.</p>
