### **Annex 3 – Miscellaneous**

1. The information regarding the names of medicines and medical devices and their quantities as provided in Annexes 1 and 2 was compiled with the reference to “The Interagency Emergency Health Kit: Medicines and medical devices for 10,000 people for approximately 3 months” and “The New Emergency Health Kit 98: Drug and Medical Supplies for 10,000 People for Approximately 3 Months” as published by the World Health Organization. In addition, the domestic trauma treatment concept was also taken into account.
2. With regard to the quantities of medicines and medical devices as reserved by the public and private hospitals –
  - (1) Medical Centers shall reserve twice the amount as required under these tables (enough supplies for 200 trauma patients)
  - (2) Regional Hospitals shall reserve the amount as required under these tables (enough supplies for 100 trauma patients)
  - (3) District Hospitals shall reserve half of the amount as required under these tables (enough supplies for 50 trauma patients)
3. For items with an asterisk before its reference number, the municipal, county and city government health authorities shall prioritise the checking when carrying out inspections for compliance.
